ORAL ORDER

2 25-06-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The grievance of the petitioner in the present writ application relates to payment of GPF amount for the year 1971-72 to 1986-87 with statutory interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner joined the service as Gram Sewak at Harnaut block on 8.12.1971 and worked there till 31.12.1986. He further submits that provident fund of the petitioner was deducted from his salary each month.

Considering the fact that the grievance of the petitioner is only confined to payment of GPF amount, the writ



petition is disposed of with a direction to the District Provident Fund Officer, Nalanda, Bihar Sharif to verify the record and ascertain about deduction of the GPF amount of the petitioner. In the event, the GPF amount of the petitioner was deducted as mentioned hereinabove, he shall ensure payment of GPF amount to the petitioner alongwith calculation chart within a period of three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, failing which the petitioner shall be entitled to payment of additional interest @ 9 % from the date of filing of the writ application till the date of actual payment.

With the aforesaid, the writ application stands disposed of.
