3 13-05-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioners are in custody in connection with Barachatii (Mohanpur) P.S. Case No. 42 of 2020 for the offence under section 30(gh) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In the instant case total 750 kg. Mahua Flower was seized from a Tempo and it is alleged that seeing police both of them tried to flee away but apprehended.

The petitioners are in custody since 24.1.2020.



Considering the submission of the counsel for the petitioners and the fact that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, let the petitioners, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing their personal bond to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge,Excise, Gaya, in connection with Barachatti (Mohanpur) P.S. Case No. 42 of 2020 on account of total lock-down due to Covid-19 pandemic.
