2 02-06-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Thawe
P.S. Case No. 208 of 2019 for the offence under Sections 147,
148, 341, 323, 324 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody
since 11.02.2019. He further submits that the allegation is
general and omnibus and there is no specific overt act against
the petitioner. The nature of injuries are simple in nature.

Considering the totality of the facts situation, the
petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on
furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five
thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the
satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj in



connection with Thawe P.S. Case No. 208 of 2019 with the condition that the petitioner on release will render his service as volunteer for a period of three months in dedicated Covid Hospital. He is required to report to the Nodal Officer in the concerned region, who shall utilize his service in this pandemic.
