learned counsel for the State via video conferencing.

Despite valid service of notice to the opposite party
no.2, she has chosen not to contest the application filed by the
petitioner for grant of pre-arrest bail in connection with
Complaint Case No.1288 of 2015 in which cognizance has been
taken for the offences punishable under Section 498A of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Considering the nature of allegation, the plea made
in the application and the submissions advanced at the Bar, the
petitioner is directed to be released on bail in event of arrest or
surrender in the court below on furnishing bail bond of
