ORAL ORDER

2 03-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner is accused in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No. 356 of 2018 registered under Section 30(a) (b) of the Excise Act.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that earlier prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail was rejected vide Cr. Misc. No. 45891 of 2019 on 24.07.2019 by a Bench of this Court with observation that the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after six months, if no substantive progress is made in the trial. Further submission is that after lapse of six months, there is no substantive progress in the trial. Petitioner is in custody since 18.09.2018, having no criminal antecedent.



Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Begusarai in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No. 356 of 2018.
