ORAL ORDER

5 10-11-2020 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State through video conferencing.

Petitioner is in jail custody since 27.7.2018 in connection with Sonapur Rail P.S. Case No. 91 of 2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 8 / 20 / 22 of the Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act.

The trial court has reported that the case of this petitioner is pending for argument.

Considering this aspect of the matter, that in huge quantity ganja was recovered and now the case of the petitioner is on the verge of conclusion, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail and, accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.



However, learned trial court is directed to dispose of the case within four months from the date of receipt / production of copy of this order.

It is made clear that if the case of the petitioner is not disposed of within the above stated period of four months, petitioner may renew his prayer for bail.
