2 03-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of committing torture
and caused death of the victim due to non-fulfillment of demand
of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 24-11-2019. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. The petitioner is mother-in-law of the
deceased. She is separate in mess and property from husband of
the deceased. She has no concern with the affairs of husband of



the deceased. The husband of the petitioner is in custody.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Piprakothi P.S. Case No. 108 of 2019.
