learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Phulwariya P.S. Case No. 274 of 2019 for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing his personal bond to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum- Special Judge, Excise Act, Gopalganj in connection with Phulwariya P.S. Case No. 274 of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
