2 13-05-2020 This matter is taken up through video conferencing.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 37(b), 45 and 52 of
the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Petitioner is in custody since 07.02.2020. Petitioner
has got no criminal antecedent. Allegation is that country made
liquor was recovered from the house of the petitioner and some
other co-accused. Prosecution report has been submitted without
proper investigation of the case.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of
Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the



like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Excise Case No. 57 of 2020, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

If the petitioner would not be able to furnish sureties due to lock-down, he shall be provisionally released on his personal bond and the provisional bail shall be confirmed only after production of the bailors within fifteen days of restoration of normal function of the Court.
