“for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the letter no. P/V-4-1011/2011/4695/P.Ra. Dinank 17.007.2016 whereby and whereunder the selection of Secretary Gram Kachahari has been commence. The instant Advertisement has been made only with a view to select Secretary Gram Kachhari but said notification does not disclose reservation for person suffering from multiple disability as contemplated in Sub Section 4 of right of person with disabilities act 2016 although in terms of constitutional scheme equality opportunity in



matters of public employment is compulsory despite in the instant advertisement for persons belonging from class physical disabilities have not been provided reservation.

Further stop functioning of newly selected Secretary Gram Kachahari, because their selection is void, ab-initio due to in absence of reservation roaster.”

After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Permission is granted.

Petition stands disposed of as withdrawn.

Interlocutory application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
