through video-conferencing, under the orders of Hon'ble the
Chief Justice, in view of Nation passing through lockdown as an
aftermath of the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Excise
Case No.938 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is
no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner
rather 117 litres of foreign liquor has been recovered from the
sugarcane field. Learned counsel for the petitioner further
submits that the petitioner has clean antecedent. Learned
counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is
innocent and has committed no offence. Learned counsel for the



petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in jail custody since 10.01.2020.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the bail petition.

Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand) in the PM Cares fund, bearing Account No.2121PM20202, IFSC Code: SBIN 0000691, SWIFT Code: SBININBB104, State Bank of India, New Delhi Main Branch, UPI ID : pmcares@sbi.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) only with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-Ixth cum Special Judge, Excise, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Excise Case No.938 of 2019.

The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned Court below on showing receipt of deposit of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand) in the PM Cares fund.
