2 17-08-2020 Due to COVID-19 Pandemic, the matter is being taken up
by way of virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading 'For
Orders' under the orders of Hon'ble the Chief Justice.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 308/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Allegation is that the accused persons including the
petitioner stopped the motorcycle of the informant and accused
Prince Kumar and Rahul Kumar assaulted him and other accused
assaulted his friend.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of
tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner



has falsely been implicated in the present case. Due to land dispute free fight is alleged to have taken place. There is no allegation of assault alleged against the petitioner.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the complaint case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and also the lockdown, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on his personal bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khagaria in connection with Khagaria P.S. case No.618 of 2018 corresponding to G.R. No.2512 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Once the normalcy is restored, the petitioner shall furnish bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each within a period of seven weeks to the satisfaction of the court concerned in connection with the aforesaid case.
