ORAL ORDER

2 07-07-2020 Heard the parties through video conferencing.

This application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner for modification of the order, dated 16.07.2019, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 31658 of 2018 by this Court with regard to extension of period of surrender of the petitioner in connection with Barh P.S. Case No. 47 of 2017, pending in the Court of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barh, Patna.

It appears that vide order, dated 16.07.2019, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 31658 of 2018 the petitioner in the event of his surrender within six weeks from the date of the aforesaid order, was granted the privilege of pre-arrest bail by this Court in connection with Barh P.S. Case No. 47 of 2017, pending in the



Court of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barh, Patna, but, for the reasons, mentioned in this application, the petitioner could not surrender before the Court, concerned, within the stipulated period, as granted by this Court.

In that view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for modification of the order, dated 16.07.2019, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 31658 of 2018 by this Court in this regard.

Let the period of surrender of the petitioner in connection with the aforesaid case before the Court, concerned, be extended for a further period of six weeks from today.

The order, dated 16.07.2019, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 31658 of 2018 by this Court is modified to aforesaid extent only.

Accordingly, this application is disposed off.
