learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Sikandra P.S. Case No. 222 of 2018 for the offence under
Sections 363 and 364 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not
committed any offence. In fact, the co-accused having more
or less similar allegation has already been granted regular
bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No.
35741 of 2019 and the case of this petitioner stands on
similar footing. The petitioner is rotting in judicial custody
since 17.01.2019. Hence, the petitioner may be enlarged on



regular bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Judicial Magistrate-1st, Jamui, in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case No. 222 of 2018.
