This matter is taken up through video conferencing.

Heard.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a),32(2),41(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 12.02.2020.

Allegation is that recovery of liquor was made not from possession of this petitioner rather from the house of the co-accused and from the road side.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection



with Lalganj P.S. Case No.188 of 2019, subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

If the petitioner would not be able to furnish sureties due to lock-down, he shall be provisionally released on his personal bond and the provisional bail shall be confirmed only after production of the bailors within fifteen days of restoration of normal function of the Court.
