ORAL ORDER

2 08-07-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking bail in connection with Khagaul P.S. Case No. 104 of 2019 registered for offences under sections 394/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner has earlier moved before this Court with a prayer for bail but, this Court, vide its order dated 25.11.2019 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 75161 of 2019, had rejected the same with a liberty to the petitioner to renew his prayer after nine months of his judicial custody.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is languishing in jail custody since 10.6.2019.

Looking to the entirety as also considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above



named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-V, Danapur, Patna in connection with Khagaul P.S. Case No. 104 of 2019, subject to the condition that (i) one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner (ii) if the petitioner is found involved in future in similar type of case, the prosecution will be at liberty to make prayer for cancellation of his bail and the court below will pass necessary order, including cancellation of bail and (iii) the petitioner would cooperate the proceeding of the court below. In event of failure to appear on two consecutive dates, the court below will be at liberty to pass the order, including cancellation of bail bonds.
