The petitioner seeks bail in **Mahila P.S. Case No. 24
of 2019 G.R. No. 4466/2019**, registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 323, 341, 504, 498(A), 494 and 34 of
the Indian Penal Code and section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition
Act.

Petitioner happens to be the husband of informant.

As per prosecution case, the marriage of informant



Sangam Kumari was solemnized with Chintu Kumar (petitioner) on 24.06.2018. After marriage, petitioner and his family members started demanding dowry and due to non-fulfillment of the same, they subjected the informant to mental and physical torture. Ultimately, on 15.11.2018 they ousted her from her matrimonial house.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner is ready to keep his wife with full honour and dignity. Petitioner is in custody since 28.12.2019 having clean antecedent.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the fact that petitioner is ready to keep his wife with full dignity and honour, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned **Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai** in connection with **Mahila P.S. Case No. 24 of 2019 G.R. No. 4466/2019** subject to following conditions:-

(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates



without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the court below.

(ii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
