ORAL ORDER

2 17-06-2020 The Office has reported that this petition suffers from several defects. However, learned counsel Mr. Ravindra Kumar, appearing for petitioner undertakes that all the defects shall be removed when the Court starts physical function.

Heard Mr. Ravindra Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as Mr. Pramod Kumar Pandey, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 63/2020 registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Near about 40 liter liquor is said to have been recovered from the house of petitioner. Furthermore, it would



appear from the perusal of record that petitioner, his brother as well as his father were made accused and his father disclosed that he used to sell illicit liquor with the help of petitioner as well as other co-accused.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna/concerned court in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 63/2020.
