Conferencing.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and 32(2) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Name of the petitioner surfaced in the confessional
statement of co-accused Basant Kumar Sahni from whose
possession liquor was recovered. Petitioner has got no criminal
antecedent. Investigation of the case is already complete against
the petitioner.

Hence, let the petitioner, above named, be released on
bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty
Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Angarghat Police Station Case No. 101 of 2019, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.
