The matter has been listed under the heading “For Orders”
under the orders of Hon’ble the Chief Justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove
the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of
four weeks from the date of lifting of the lockdown in the State
of Bihar.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Section 30(a) of the Excise Act.

The prosecution case, in short, is that 70 liters wine is
recovered.



It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. Charge sheet/Prosecution report in this case has already been submitted. The petitioner is in custody since 29-01-2020. It is alleged that 70 liters wine is recovered in this case. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Nawada in connection with Kawakole P.S. Case No. 212 of 2019.
