Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Bihar

School Examination Board on instructions submits that the



Board will verify the claim of the petitioner and issue original mark-sheet of Class 12th and certificate in the next week.

Considering the stand taken by Mr. Girijesh Kumar, learned counsel for the Board, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Secretary, Bihar School Examination Board (respondent no. 2) to issue necessary certificate and original mark-sheet of Class 12th to the petitioner latest by 16th of June, 2020. However, the petitioner may approach the respondent nos. 7 to 10 for taking appropriate action in relation of the selection and appointment of the petitioner as Airman.

Mr. S.D. Sanjay, learned Additional Solicitor General may convey respondent nos. 7 to 10 that during pandemic if there is any delay occurred on the part of the Board in issuing the original mark-sheet and certificate, that may be ignored on humanitarian ground having regard to the special circumstances.

With the aforesaid, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
