Let the defects be removed within two weeks after
opening of the physical court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Sections 272/273/34 of the Indian
Penal Code and Sections 30(a)/56(k)/(56(kh)) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

Submission is that no liquor was recovered from the
physical possession or house of the petitioner. The petitioner has
stated on oath that he has got no criminal antecedent.
Investigation of the case is already complete.



Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Aurai (Muzaffarpur) P.S. Case No.68 of 2020, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
