3 02-11-2020 This matter has been taken up in virtual Court.

Let the defects be removed within 15 days of the start
of the physical Court.

Heard the parties.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offence punishable under Sections 328 and 304(B)/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is husband of the victim of dowry death.
Allegation is of demand of dowry and torture for the same.

Learned counsel for the informant is appearing and
submits that in fact no first information was lodged by the
informant rather police had taken her signature on blank paper
which was converted into F.I.R.

Considering the resilience of the informant from her



stand and completion of investigation, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20000/- (Twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 84 of 2018, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
