“(i) To issue direction to the respondents to remove the illegal encroachment made by the respondent No.8 Nandu Ra over the Samudaik Bhawan constructed by the State of Bihar and Public Possession over the Samudaiyak Bhawan situated at Khata No.116, 115 Thana No.46, Tauzi No.3029 Khashra No.1325 Area 1 Katha situated at Mauza- Rajpur Gram Panchayat Dayalpur Daulatpur, P.S.- Bihta, District- Patna (Bihar).

(ii) For any other relief or reliefs as your



Lordships may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

It is brought to our notice that petitioner’s representation is already pending before appropriate authority.

As jointly prayed for, the petition stands disposed of in the following terms:-

(a) petitioner’s representation, (Annexure-4), which is pending before the appropriate authority, shall be considered and decided in accordance with law;

(b) they shall do within a period of three months from today;

(c) liberty is reserved to the petitioner to take recourse to such remedy, if so required, pursuant to the decision taken on such representation;

(d) we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter;
