2 15-09-2020 Due to COVID-19 Pandemic, the matter is being
taken up by way of virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading ‘For
Orders’ under the orders of Hon’ble the Chief Justice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove the defects, as pointed out by the office, within a period
of four weeks from the date of lifting of the lockdown in the
State of Bihar.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 341, 323, 307, 354, 504 of the I.P.C.

Prosecution case, in short, is that the accused persons
including the petitioner assaulted the father and mother of the



informant by means of iron rod, fists and slaps, due to which they sustained injuries.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 29.02.2020 and has got no criminal antecedent. Charge sheet has been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is a case and counter case between the parties. For a petty reason the alleged occurrence is said to have taken place. The injuries on the side of the accused persons have not been explained by the prosecution. The prosecution has not come with clean hands.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate II, Gaya in connection with Alipur P.S. case No.35 of 2019.
