2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in

connection with Samastipur Town P.S. Case No.223 of 2019

registered under Sections 420, 354B, 504, 379/34 of the Indian

Penal Code.

3. Considering that save and except the fact that

Cellular No.9304423100 belongs to the petitioner there is no

other material to connect him with the alleged offence and the

statement made in para-3 of the application that he has got no

criminal antecedent, he is directed to be released on bail, in the

event of his arrest or surrender, on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge, Samastipur in connection with Samastipur Town P.S. Case No.223 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

4. Since the court proceedings are being conducted through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-
