This Letters Patent Appeal is directed against the judgment dated 02.06.2020 passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court in CWJC No.5720/2020 titled as Nikesh Kumar Savri Versus The State of Bihar & Ors., whereby and whereunder the writ



application filed by the Appellants has been dismissed.

After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the appellants seeks permission to withdraw the present appeal, reserving liberty to file an application seeking review/recall of the judgment placing on record the entire material, which allegedly the appellants/petitioners were precluded from placing on record before the learned Single Judge in view of the restriction with regard to number of pages to be filed in an application, so imposed by the registry.
