ORAL ORDER

2 07-09-2020 Filing through email of the present application has been accepted in view of the out-break of COVID-19 Pandemic and has been posted before me for hearing through video conferencing.

The application is apparently not in accordance with the provisions prescribed under the Patna High Court Rules, which do not contemplate filing of application through email. In



spite of that, considering the extra-ordinary situation, filing of the present application has been allowed through email.

Considering the situation prevailing, the Court has considered, for the present, to ignore the deficiency in filing of the application.

Heard Mr. Dr. Anjani Pd. Singh, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. G.P. Ojha, learned Government Advocate-7 appearing for the respondent-State.

After some arguments, Dr. Anjani Pd. Singh, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a suit for compensation before the civil court of competent jurisdiction.

Leave is granted.

The writ petition is disposed of.

Since the court proceedings are being conducted through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-
