Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State through video conference. Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes that all defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter shall be removed, and compliance with the conditions of the notices of this Court with regard to acceptance of e-filing shall be made, without delay immediately after the lockdown ends, and in any event within one month thereof.

2. The petitioners are in custody since 10.02.2020 in connection with Abadpur P.S. Case No. 14 of 2020 for the offences alleged under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 307, 353, 332, 333, 427, 436 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.



3. It is submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated and the F.I.R. is against as many as 48 named and 500 unknown persons. The accusations are general and omnibus in nature without any specific accusation attributed to the petitioners. Similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court, for instance in Cr. Misc. No. 18490 of 2020. The petitioners claim clean antecedents.

4. Learned APP appears and has been heard.

5. Be that as it may and having regard to the period of custody already suffered since 10.02.2020, let the petitioners above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Katihar, in connection with Abadpur P.S. Case No. 14 of 2020, if he is not otherwise required in any other case.

6. Office shall ensure that all defects have been removed and compliance with the notices of this Court has been made, within the stipulated time as provided in para-1 hereinabove.
