2 14-10-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with
Bhagwan Bazar P.S. Case No. 134 of 2019 for the offence
under section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that name
of the petitioner surfaced on the confessional statement of co-
accused. He further submits that nothing has been recovered
from the possession of the petitioner to connect this petitioner in
the commission of crime.

Considering the aforesaid, the Court is inclined to
grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the condition
that the petitioner shall deposit Rs. 15000/- cash in the court
below and on depositing of Rs. 15000/- the court below shall



released the e petitioner, named above, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Bhagwan Bazar P.S. Case No. 134 of 2019 subject to the condition as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The amount of Rs. 15000/- cash deposited by the petitioner shall abide by final outcome of the pending criminal case.
