ORAL ORDER

2 19-08-2020 Filing through email of the present application has been accepted in view of the out-break of COVID-19 Pandemic and has been posted before me for hearing through video conferencing.

The application is apparently not in accordance with the provisions prescribed under the Patna High Court Rules, which do not contemplate filing of application through email. In spite of that, considering the extra-ordinary situation, filing of the present application has been allowed through email.

Considering the situation prevailing, the Court has considered, for the present, to ignore the deficiency in filing of the application.



Heard Mr. Binod Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners and Smt. Meena Singh, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Gogri P.S. Case No. 57 of 2020, G.R. No.523 of 2020 registered under Sections 448, 341, 323, 307, 354-A, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering that though there is omnibus and general allegation against the petitioners that they also participated in commission of the offence, the specific case of the prosecution is that it was co-accused Mukesh Singh, who assaulted with *lathi* on the head of the informant, who had sustained only one injury on his head and another injury found on his person was on tip of right little finger, they are directed to be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khagaria in connection with Gogri P.S. Case No. 57 of 2020, G.R. No.523 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Since the court proceedings are being conducted



through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-

- (i) The order, which has been dictated during the course of proceeding of the virtual court, shall be communicated to me on my email by the Sr. Secretary.
