ORAL ORDER

4 03-09-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for regular bail arises out of Rajgir P.S. Case No. 470 of 2019, disclosing offence punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation is of commission of *dacoity* in Bank during broad day light. The miscreants were allegedly carrying fire-arms. The FIR was registered against unknown. In course of investigation, name of the petitioner and others surfaced. It appears that the accused persons were arrested, who confessed their involvement in the commission of the offence and some of the looted articles were recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Considering the gravity of the offence, I am not



inclined to grant the petitioner privilege of regular bail.

This application is accordingly rejected.

It is directed that defects in the application pointed out by the Registry must be removed within two months from today.

Since there is a lockdown, the Court has considered it appropriate to adopt following procedure for communication of the present order:-
