2 12-11-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned counsel for the State via video conferencing.

The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection
with Complaint Case No. 2901 of 2018 in which cognizance has
been taken under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code and
Section 138 of N.I. Act.

Considering the nature of the offence as also the
fact that the cheque which got dishonored was issued under the
signature of co-accused Rajesh Kumar Bhagat, the petitioners



are directed to be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-6th Muzaffarpur in connection with Complaint Case No. 2901 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Since the court proceedings are being conducted through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-

- (i) The order, which has been dictated during the course of proceeding of the virtual court, shall be communicated to me on my e-mail by the Sr. Secretary.
- (ii) The corrected copy of the order shall be transmitted by me from my e-mail id to the Sr. Secretary, which shall be treated to be an authentic copy of the order passed by this Court in the present proceeding.
