2 03-07-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Paroo
P.S. Case No. 90 of 2020, for the offence under Sections 270.
272 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30, 30(a)(c)
(d), 33 and 36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
14.02.2020. He further submits that in the instant case total 25
litres of spirit was seized from a plastic gallon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
nothing was recovered from conscious possession of the
petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal



antecedent and he is in custody since 14.02.2020, the Court is inclined to grant bail him. The petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise Muzaffarpur in connection with Paroo P.S. Case No. 90 of 2020.
