ORAL ORDER

3 20-07-2020 An order was passed on 21.07.2020 in Cr. Misc. No. 21347 of 2020. However, the date of order has been wrongly typed as ‘20.07.2020’ in place of ‘21.07.2020’. It is accordingly directed that the said order shall be treated to have been passed on 21.07.2020.

Let the said order be withdrawn from the Court's website by the Registry with the help of N.I.C. and a fresh order be generated and uploaded, passed on 21.07.2020 in Cr. Misc. No. 21347 of 2020, accordingly.

Because of the ongoing pandemic situation and surge in COVID-19 cases, it may be inconvenient or difficult for the Registry to implement the present order. It is, therefore,



observed, in exceptional circumstance, that the petitioner shall not be taken into custody and no coercive steps shall be taken against him in the meanwhile in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 267 of 2016, pending in the court of learned ACJM-II, Danapur, Patna.
