ORAL ORDER

2 13-10-2020 Heard Mr. Ajay Kumar Sinha, learned counsel

appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Smt. Anita Kumari,

learned Additional Public Prosecutor, for the State of Bihar.

This application for grant of regular bail arises out of
Excise P.S. Case No. 170/2020, registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 30(a) and 57(a) of Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2018.

The petitioner is in custody since 17.03.2020. It is
alleged in the First Information report that a police patrol party
had intercepted a motorcycle, from which 90 liters of illicit
liquor was recovered. The petitioner was apprehended on the
spot.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
has submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and



he had simply taken a lift on a motorcycle, which belonged to the co-accused.

Be that as it may, considering the fact noted above and the petitioner's custody since 17.03.2020, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Excise Judge, Gaya, in Excise P.S. Case No. 170/2020.

It is directed that the defect(s) in the application, pointed out by the Registry, must be removed within two months.

Since COVID-19 Pandemic situation is prevailing, the Court has considered it appropriate to adopt following procedure for communication of the present order :-

(i) The order, which has been dictated during the course of the proceedings of virtual Court, shall be communicated to me on my e-mail I.D. by the Secretary.
