appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Anzarul Haque
Sahara, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, for the State of
Bihar.

The petitioner was allowed regular bail by an order
09.06.2020, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 18811 of 2020 on
furnishing sureties/bonds to the satisfaction of learned XI Addl.
Sessions Judge, Muzaffarpur, in Sadar P.S. Case No. 417 of
2018. Satisfaction of learned XI Addl. Sessions Judge,
Muzaffarpur was mentioned in the order on the basis of the
averments made in the application to the effect that the matter
was pending before learned Addl. Sessions Judge- XI.

Present application has been filed seeking



modification of the said order only to the extent that in place of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-XI, satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur be read in the said order dated 09.06.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 18811 of 2020.

Considering the statement made in paragraph 5 of the application that the case is presently pending before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur, the said order dated 09.06.2020 is modified and it is accordingly directed that in place of satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-XI, satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate shall be read in the said order dated 09.06.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 18811 of 2020 in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 417 of 2018.

It is directed that defects pointed out by the stamp reporter, be removed within two months.
