Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated
15.01.2019 (Annexure-1) whereby he was put under suspension
on account of his involvement in a trap case by the Vigilance
Department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is under suspension till date whereas in the case of
similarly circumstanced persons, suspension has been revoked
as such, the respondents have acted arbitrarily.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has been
subjected to departmental proceeding and the petitioner has



submitted his reply to the show cause under Rule 17(4) of the Bihar Government Servant (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules 2005, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to conclude the departmental proceeding within a period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, failing which the order of suspension shall automatically stand revoked.

With the aforesaid observation and direction, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
