ORAL ORDER**

2 15-09-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State through virtual court proceeding.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defects as pointed out by the office within two
weeks of normal functioning of the court, failing which the
office is directed to place the matter before the Bench.

This application has been filed for modification of
the order dated 03.03.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 9444 of
2020 for extension of time for furnishing bail bond mentioned in
order passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has been granted bail on 03.03.2020 passed in Cr.



Misc. No. 9444 of 2020, subject to deposit of Rs.1,00,000/- (one lac) in the Juvenile Justice Fund of the State Social Welfare Department by the petitioner, but due to lockdown, the petitioner could not deposit Rs.1,00,000/- (one lac) in the Juvenile Justice Fund of the State Social Welfare Department within the time directed by this Hon'ble Court.

Considering the same, let the period of surrender of the petitioner be extended by four weeks from today, subject to deposit of Rs.1,00,000/- (one lac) by the petitioner in the Juvenile Justice Fund of the State Social Welfare Department in connection with Sakra P.S. Case No. 455 of 2019 to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Muzaffarpur.

Rest of the condition as stipulated in the order dated 03.03.2020 shall remain as it is.

Accordingly, the modification is allowed.
