Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Sursand P.S. Case No. 19
of 2018, registered for the offence punishable under Section
304(B) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the daughter of informant was
married with this petitioner in the year 2013. It is alleged that
the daughter of the informant was not blessed with any child
and for this reason, she was subjected to cruelty and torture by
the accused persons including this petitioner. The accused
persons also used to demand motorcycle in dowry. Ultimately,



on 05.02.2018, the daughter of informant was done to death due to non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner is the husband of deceased. The deceased died due to ailment. Petitioner used to reside in Delhi for his livelihood. Petitioner is in custody since 28.01.2020 having clean antecedent.

It appears that deceased died at her sasural within seven years of her marriage and petitioner is husband of the deceased.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the fact that petitioner is husband of the deceased, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner above-named on bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.
