The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection
with Complaint Case No. 474 of 2019, T.R. No. 1693 of 2019
registered for the offence punishable under Section 498-A of the
Indian Penal Code.

Considering the nature of the offence, the
allegation made against the petitioner, the pleadings made in the
application preferred under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. and the
submissions advanced at the Bar, the provisional pre-arrest bail
granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.07.2020 is hereby



confirmed.
