ORAL ORDER

2 05-11-2020 This matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing.

Let the defects be removed within two weeks after opening of the physical court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Liquor was recovered from the riverside. Allegation is that the same was of the petitioner. The petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact that there is no direct material



against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Excise Police Station Case No.465 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
