3 12-11-2020 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of habeas Corpus, order or direction to quash the order dated 4.10.2019 as contained in Memo No.7/CCA-10-16/2019 H.D.8380/Patna dated 4.10.2019 issued by Under Secretary to the State Government approving the preventive detention order dated 5.9.2019 as contained in Memo No.1-01/19-2666/dt. 5.9.2019 issued by the District Magistrate, Patna by which the petitioner is being preventively detained under the Bihar



Control of Crime Act, 1981 for the maximum period of one year and thus both the orders dated 4.10.2019 and 5.9.2019 are liable to be set aside as passed on irrelevant and erroneous ground.”

In view of the intervening development, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, more so, for the reason that the same has become infructuous.

However, learned counsel prays liberty to file fresh petition, if so required, on the subsequent cause of action.

This Court is of the view that no liberty is required but nonetheless, as prayed for, liberty is granted.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
