ORAL ORDER

5 23-12-2020 Heard Mr. Pramod Mishra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Mritunjay Kumar Gautam, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, for the State of Bihar.

This application for grant of regular bail arises out of Gwalpara P.S. Case No. 01 of 2015, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 399/411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, after some arguments, seeks permission to withdraw this application with a liberty to renew his prayer for regular bail after some time, if there is no substantial progress at the trial.

This application is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as sought for.

It is directed that the defect(s) in the application, pointed out by the Registry, must be removed within two



months.
