3 01-12-2020 Due to COVID-19 Pandemic, the matter is being
taken up by way of Virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading ‘For
Orders’ under the orders of Hon’ble the Chief Justice.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution allegation, in short, is that the accused
persons looted motorcycle and other articles from the informant
while he was going to his house with one another person.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 30.12.2019 and has got no
criminal antecedent. Charge-sheet/prosecution report has been



submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The only material is that the looted motorcycle is said to have been found parked by the side of the house of the petitioner. Except for this, there is no other substantive evidence to suggest his implication in the present case. The petitioner has not been put on T.I.P. to ascertain his participation in the alleged occurrence.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Amarpur P.S. Case No. 348 of 2019.
