counsel for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Vigilance P.S.
Case No. 04 of 2019 registered for the offence under section 7(a)
of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier
prayer of the petitioner for bail was rejected by a Bench of this
Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 45254 of 2019 (Annexure-1) on
29.07.2019 with a direction to the trial court to expedite the trial
within a period of nine months, but after lapse of 11 months, the



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trial has not been concluded. Further he submits that now the fresh ground is that the petitioner is in custody since 19.01.2019.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Vigilance-I, Patna in connection with Special Case No. 07 of 2019 arising out of Vigilance Case No. 04 of 2019.
