Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
and Mr. Anil Kumar Singh No.1, learned Additional Public
Prosecutor, for the State of Bihar.

This application for grant of regular bail arises out of
Sikandra P.S. Case No. 40 of 2020, registered for the offence
punishable under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged in the First Information Report that the
petitioner was found riding in a motorcycle, which was stolen
and for which Halasi P.S. Case No. 75 of 2018 was registered.
The petitioner was apprehended on 12.02.2020 and since then
he is in custody.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
has submitted that the petitioner has been wrongly implicated in



the case and he has no concern with the recovered motorcycle.

Considering the nature of offence alleged against the petitioner and since, according to him, he does not have any criminal antecedent, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M. Ist Class, Jamui, in Sikandra P.S. Case No. 40 of 2020.

It is directed that the defect(s) in the application, pointed out by the Registry, must be removed within two months.
