disposed of in terms of judgment dated 14.11.2017 passed in LPA No. 501 of 2017 (*Ajit Kumar Vs. the State of Bihar & others*). The impugned order of termination is set aside. Petitioner is directed to be reinstated. However, payment of arrears of salary as well as future payment of salary shall abide by the final outcome of criminal case and enquiry pending with regard to the genuineness of the certificate of the petitioner. The respondents shall take all steps for expeditious disposal of the pending proceeding.
