This matter has been taken up in virtual court.

Let the defects be removed within 15 days of the
start of the physical Court.

Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections
147/148/149/341/323/307/504/379/427 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

There is no specific allegation against the
petitioner rather specific allegation is against the named
accused to have caused fire arm injury and theft.

Mr. Arjun Prasad, learned counsel for the
informant opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner



who has got no criminal antecedent, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Rajauli P.S. Case No. 08 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
