Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Mohania P.S. Case No. 61
of 2020, registered for the offence punishable punishable under
Section 30(a)/36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

4888.785 litres of liquor is said to have been
recovered from a truck. Petitioner is alleged to be the driver of
said vehicle.

It is submitted that petitioner has falsely been
implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from
conscious possession of this petitioner. Petitioner has no



concern with the seized liquor and he has no knowledge about the illicit liquor which was loaded on the truck. Petitioner is in custody since 26.02.2020 having clean antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional and Sessions Judge III-cum-Special Judge Excise, Kaimur at Bhabua in connection with Mohania P.S. Case No. 61 of 2020, subject to following conditions:-

(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the court below.

(ii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
